II. The Aim of the Festival

2. The aim of the Festival is to promote:

- 2.1. identification and recognition of traditional and art quilt as well as the preservation, further development and growth of this unique sewing technique in Latvia;
- 2.2. creative cooperation with similar organizations and artists abroad;
- 2.3. improvement of the professional level of quilters and artists as well as motivating the schoolchildren and youth to create new interesting works;
- 2.4. organization of educational and practical seminars in Riga and Latvia in order to enhance the quality of the works;
- 2.5. cooperation with schools and educational centres of interests in Riga in order to popularize quilting, to create the cultural environment and to foster educated viewers.

IV. Developments of the Festival

- 4.1. The opening of the Festival on 18th August 2018 at 12 p.m. at Cultural Palace “Ziemeļblazma”, Ziemeļblazmas Street 36, Riga, Latvia.
- 4.2. The exhibition program at Cultural Palace “Ziemeļblazma”, Ziemeļblazmas Street 36, Riga will take place from 18th August 2017 until 8th September 2018 from 9 a.m. till 6 p.m.
 - 4.2.1. Exhibition of Latvian quilts “**Dedication**”;
 - 4.2.2. Exhibition of International competition of mini quilts “**Heritage**”;
 - 4.2.3. Exhibition of the competition of Latvian schoolchildren’s quilts “**My Gift to Latvia**”;
 - 4.2.4. International exhibition “**Scarves**”;
 - 4.2.5. International exhibition “**Garments and Accessories**”, opening with a Fashion show on 18th August at 12 p.m.;
 - 4.2.6. International quilt exhibition “**Classical Quilts Created Modern**” presented by Brigitte Morgenroth (Germany);
 - 4.2.7. International quilt project “**Assonance**” presented by Lyubov Lezhanina, Margarita Vorobey and Tatyana Melnikova (Russia);

- 4.3. Master classes of Latvian and foreign quilters. Detailed information will be published on the website of Latvian Quilt Association by 1st August 2018.
- 4.4. Creative workshops at creative workshop-gallery “Lolitas skapis”, Kurbada Street 2b, Riga, Latvia.
- 4.5. Closing Ceremony of the festival on 9th September 2018 at 12 p.m. at Cultural Palace “Ziemeļblazma”, Ziemeļblazmas Street 36, Riga, Latvia.

V. Submission of Entries and Rules for the Participants

- 5.1. The submissions for the quilt exhibit “**Dedication**” will be accepted only from Latvian quilters; the works can be accomplished in art quilt and traditional techniques (the quilt must consist of 3 layers - top, batting and back). Either individual or group quilts can be submitted. One quilter or a group can enter with maximum 3 pieces. There are no size limits. The Association keeps the right not to exhibit all the works submitted by one quilter or a group but guarantees the display of at least one quilt.
- 5.2. For the Exhibition of International competition of mini quilts “**Heritage**” the quilter regardless of citizenship and place of residence can submit up to 3 works. The size of a mini quilt is 21cm x 30cm (A-4size).
- 5.3. For International exhibition “**Garments and Accessories**” works accomplished in all the quilting techniques will be accepted. Either individual or

group quilts can be submitted. Number of works is not limited. The Association keeps the right not to exhibit all the works submitted by one quilter or a group but guarantees the display of at least one work.

5.4. For International exhibition “**Scarves**” the following rules have to be followed: the size of a finished scarf is 2.00 x 0.60 m (-,+ 10cm), both ends of the scarf - 30 cm (-,+ 10 cm) vertically accomplished in any of the quilting techniques.

5.5. All the submitted works must be prepared for hanging: on the top of the back side there must be sewn a tunnel (width – 10 cm), which begins and ends 2 -3 cm from the side edges. If the quilt is wider than 1.20 m the tunnel must consist of 2 parts. When submitting the quilt the rod for hanging also must be provided.

5.6. On the bottom right side on the back side of the quilt there must be a fabric label (7cm x 10cm):

5.6.1. for the works submitted to exhibition “**Dedication**” and International exhibitions “**Garments and Accessories**” and “**Scarves**”:

5.5.2. for the works submitted to exhibition of International competition of mini quilts “**Heritage**”:

5.6. All the submitted quilts must be clean, thoroughly accomplished and must agree with the Rules.

5.8. By submitting the Entry form the participant of the Festival resolves to comply with the Rules of the organizers of the Festival and do not object to taking pictures and/or film the displayed works.

5.9. All the registered works (ready for hanging) must be submitted **on 13th August 2018** from 10 a.m. until 1 p.m. at Cultural Palace “Ziemeļblazma”, Ziemeļblazmas Street 36, Riga or mailed by post until 1st August 2018 to the following address:

5.10. Authors can receive back their submitted works at the venue after the closure of the Festival or they will be sent by post according to the specified address in the Entry form. **The full postage of the works to and from the Festival is paid by the participant.**

5.11. The fee for participating in any of the exhibition programs (regardless in one or several) is 20 EUR (for members – 10 EUR). For group works, each co-author pays separately 20 EUR (for members – 10 EUR).

The amount of the participation fee and postage expenses can be transferred to the bank account of the Latvian Quilt Association until 1st August 2018 or paid in cash at the venue by the time of the opening of the Festival with a prior agreement with the organizers.

VI. Assessment of the Quilts displayed at the Festival

6.1. Three quilts from the exhibition “**Dedication**” will receive the viewers’ awards and Diplomas.

Independent jury will assess the works and grant “**Aina’s Muze Award**”.

6.2. The three laureates of the International competition of mini quilts “**Heritage**” will receive jurors’ awards and Diplomas.

6.3. The quilts of the International competition of mini quilts will be judged by the jurors approved by the organizers and according to the following assessment rules:

6.3.1.the most respective display of the theme of the competition,

6.3.2.the most interesting composition of the work,

6.3.3.the most professional execution of the quilting techniques,

6.3.4. the creativity.

6.4. the special consolation prizes will be awarded by the sponsors.

6.5. All the participants of the festival will receive the Acknowledgment about the participation in the Festival.
